

Awards Policy

The giving of awards is at the discretion of the Committee Directors. The guidelines given below may be used in the giving out of awards, however, directors are free to make use of different considerations as they see fit.

Directors are advised to give one Best Delegate Award and at least one Outstanding Delegate Award and Honourable Mention. In Committees of over 100 delegates, Directors are encouraged to give out at least five awards. Directors are also encouraged to give out a Best Position Paper Award, though this may not be the case in all Committees. However, Position Paper submission is a pre-requisite to all other awards.

Delegates will be assessed by Directors, and the Secretariat where needed, on considerations including but not limited to the following:

- Advocacy
- Diplomacy
- Knowledge of topics
- Contribution to resolutions
- Adherence to country policy
- Leadership
- Knowledge of broader themes in international relations, current affairs, and political thought

N.B. The decisions of the Committee Directors concerning awards are final and not subject to appeal.
